Destignatising the conversation around mental health is one of the key reasons the Screenwave International Film Festival launched the Nextwave youth program five years ago. The workshop and short film competition program has now blossomed to become the largest youth film development program in Regional Australia — and each year it chooses a mental health theme for all short films in its competition.

To celebrate Mental Health Month 2020, communities are invited to host their own screenings of SWIFF's Nextwave youth film program. It is a curated selection of 15 short films made by young regional Australians (90-minute session).
